Organics Recycling Workshops

Valley Vista Services would like to invite you to two (2) upcoming workshops where we will be educating residents living in the City of Walnut about the new **California State Law SB 1383** and household participation in our Residential Organics Recycling Program.

Tuesday, May 10 - 6 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. • **Saturday, May 14 - 10 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.**

Both workshops will be held at the Walnut Senior Center located at 21215 La Puente. Participation in the Organic Waste Recycling program is mandatory as outlined by the State of California.



Annual Curbside Cleanup - Saturday, June 11

Please prepare for our upcoming Annual Curbside Cleanup event on **Saturday, June 11, 2022**. Residents of Walnut may dispose of an unlimited amount of bulky items and/or e-waste and household appliances. Bulky items are items that are too large to fit into the standard trash cart, such as couches, tables, mattresses, rugs, stoves, refrigerators, and dishwashers. Please have all items at the curbside before 6 a.m. to ensure collection.

Household Hazardous Roundup

There will be a FREE Household Hazardous and E-Waste Roundup event on **Saturday, May 21 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.** at 825 Sunset Ave. in West Covina. Residents of LA County may come and safely dispose of hazardous materials that are too toxic to throw away into the trash. Some examples of **Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)** are brake fluid, paint, cleaners, pesticides, batteries, pool chemicals, motor oil, expired pharmaceuticals, anti-freeze, and fluorescent light bulbs. **E-Waste** includes: old computers, television sets, VCRs, radios, tablets, monitors, and any other form of electronics. **For more information on HHW disposal and roundup events in your area, visit PW.LACounty.gov/epd/hhw/Hhw or call (888) CLEAN-LA.**

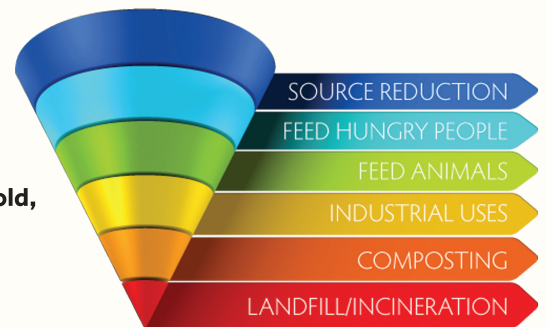


Stop Food Waste

Californians throw away nearly 6 million tons of food scraps or food waste each year. With the recent passage of State Laws, AB 1828 and SB 1383, which require the mandatory recycling of organic waste and the rescuing of edible food, every Californian will have a role in helping the State achieve these 3 goals:

1. **REDUCE** the amount of food waste generated
2. **DONATE** more safe, nutritious food to people in need
3. **RECYCLE** unavoidable food waste, diverting it from landfills
